- **UCBP's core team meeting** will take place with the purpose of ensuring an effective intra-departmental cooperation and flow of information in the run up to the year-end closing. Regional managers, site managers and engineers will attend the team meeting which will be held on 06 November 2010 at the GTZ IS ET Head Office.

Infos from the sites...

- **Dr. Christoph Beier**, GTZ Managing Director, and **Mr. Volkmar Klein**, Member of German Parliament and Member of the Supervisory Board of GTZ, will visit the UCBP Axum site on 02 November 2010, as part of their official visit to the work of GTZ in Ethiopia.

Facts about Axum

- Once it's finished, the university can accommodate 9000 students. While 2700 students have already graduated in July 2010, 3000 students have been enrolled in September 2010.
- From the 80 buildings, 57 of them are functioning as class rooms, administration rooms, dining halls, dormitories etc. The remaining buildings are under construction.
- **25,000 square meters** of pedestrian roads are currently paved with cobblestone in Adama. Other sites including Kombolcha, Dire Dawa, Semera, Debre Birhan, and Jijiga will conclude the contracts and start the implementation shortly, while the remaining sites will also follow within this month.
- While 171 **main buildings'** final acceptance is completed, another 115 buildings are provisionally handed over in September 2010. Moreover, 398 main buildings' final handover is expected in the coming two months.
- After four years of service, the **GTZ IS Dukem warehouse** has been closed down at the end of September 2010. As a result, all construction related materials have been distributed to all the respective UCBP sites.
