Infos from Addis Ababa...

- A **Memorandum of Cooperation** was concluded on 17 March 2011 between Anhalt University and Addis Ababa University. In addition, a licensing and collaboration agreement was signed in view of the creation of an Institute for Membrane and Shell Technologies in Ethiopia in the presence of State Minister Hailemeskel Tefera (Ministry of Urban Development and Construction) and Dr. Yilma Seleshi, Head of the Department of Civil Engineering, Institute of Technology, Addis Ababa University.
- Dr. Elmar Kleiner, Director General will **visit** Addis Ababa from 7-8 April 2011 and will meet with GIZ IS staff.
- **UCBP evaluation meeting** will take place on the second week of April 2011.
